- 2. Entries must be written by the submitting author(s) and cannot have won a previous contest. The story must be new written material.**
- 3. All entries are due at the library by 4 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 30, 2020.**
- 4. The contest will be judged by library staff or outside judges.**
- 5. Winning entries will be announced on the library website, Facebook page, signage around the library, the Library Ledger newsletter and winners will be contacted via phone.**
- 6. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be chosen for each age category and prizes will be awarded.**
- 7. Entries are encouraged to include an illustration if desired.**
- 8. All entries and illustrations should include the author's name, city, phone number, age, school and grade (if applicable).**
- 9. Please try to keep submissions within 1,500-2,000 words.**
- 10. Participants must fill out an official entry form to accompany their writing entry.**

- 3. High School (9th-12th)**
- 4. Adult (18+)**
